Brief BIO:

Edmund (Eddie) Orlowski is a doctoral student in counseling psychology at the University at Albany, where he is studying under Dr. Myrna Friedlander. His research interests include suicide prevention and examining the psychotherapy process. To date, his work in realm of suicide prevention has focused on disseminating and evaluating suicide risk assessment trainings for mental health professionals, evaluating Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT) for therapists, and developing an upstream suicide prevention program for middle school students. Thus far, his work studying the therapy process has focused on the nature of the working alliance and expectations for therapy in youth, couple, and family therapy.
