The term of service for the current editor, Dr. Richard M. Lee, ends on December 31, 2019.

The new editor's term will consist of two phases:

- \* serving as Editor-Elect from January 1, 2019–December 31, 2019
- \* serving as Editor from January 1, 2020-December 31, 2024

The Editor-Elect will select the Associate Editors and Editorial Board from October 1, 2018—December 31, 2018 and begin receiving manuscripts on January 1, 2019 to prepare for issues published in 2020. The Editor-Elect must be a member of Division 45. We seek an Editor-Elect who will continue the mission of the Division and build on the outstanding reputation of CDEMP.

Although not limited to the following, the committee is especially interested in a candidate's:

- \* Appreciation for, and openness to, publishing high quality manuscripts from diverse epistemological perspectives (e.g., quantitative, qualitative, mixed methods, community-based research, critical psychology perspectives, and the like).
- \* Vision for deepening the impact and relevance of scholarship on the critical issues affecting the communities of color in the United States and abroad.
- \* Responsiveness to "hot topics" related to pressing concerns of people of color in the United States and abroad.

The nomination packet should include the following items from the nominee:

- \* a statement from the candidate outlining her or his editorial experience, vision and goals for the journal, and other qualifications for the position
- \* a curriculum vitae
- \* 2 letters of reference

We encourage participation by members of underrepresented groups in the publication process and would particularly welcome such nominees. Self-nominations are welcome.

The deadline for the receipt of nomination materials is March 15, 2018.

The selection process may involve telephone interviews between finalists and members of the search committee.
