Gerald Cupchik's new book, *The aesthetics of emotion: Up the down staircase of the mind-body*, has come out in England (Cambridge University Press) and will appear in America on September 1st. However, the website at the University of Toronto dedicated to the book is now live. It includes color images from the book (available to readers on Smart Devices via QR codes), nine Open Access lectures on themes related to the book, and other materials. A series of interviews with the artists, whose works are discussed in one of the chapters, will be completed for some time in September.

The lectures cover a variety of topics bridging science and the humanities, different approaches to emotion theory, and the two sides of aesthetic creation and reception. A unified emotion theory is proposed both in the book and the videos.
